On August 3rd, 2023, Narcie Elizabeth Puckett Ball passed away peacefully at home surrounded by loved ones after a long and full life of 100 years.

She was born in Paint Lick Mountain, Virginia on September 12th, 1922. Just shy of her 20th birthday, Narcie married Nevil Ball on August 8th, 1942. In her younger years, Narcie found joy in filling the room with bluegrass music as she played the bass fiddle alongside her husband. She was fond of riding horses, tending to her garden, and attending her local church. Most of all, she loved cooking and sharing her delicious, southern dishes, her sweet mac n' cheese, and her homemade apple pies with her cherished friends and family. She was the last surviving member of her immediate family.

Narcie is preceded in death by her husband, Nevil Ball, her parents, Lewis and Eliza Puckett, three siblings, Walter, Shular, and Jean Puckett, grandson, Dale "Jr." Ball, and great-granddaughter, Cara Sheppard, along with other family members who have passed throughout the years.
