September 19, 1934 - January 12, 2012

Mrs. Patsy McGee Ringstaff, age 77, of Cedar Bluff, Virginia, passed away Thursday, January 12, 2012 in a Kingsport, TN hospital. She was born in Pounding Mill, Virginia and was the daughter of the late Elmer and Mattie Ringstaff McGee. She was a lifelong resident of the area and was a former substitute teacher for Tazewell County Public Schools.
