Paul Frank Goad, Sr., 84, of Newhall, WV went to be with his Lord peacefully in his sleep at home, Wednesday, January 26, 2005. Paul was born at Newhall, WV August 26, 1920, the son of the late William Henry Goad and Mary Magaline "Maggie" Edwards Goad. He graduated from Big Creek High School 1940, served his country during World War II as a technical sergeant in the Army Air Corp. in Panama.
