January 6, 1929 - May 3, 2022

Peery L. Woosley, age 93, of Richlands, VA passed away at his home on Tuesday, May 3, 2022, following a lengthy illness.

Peery was born in Peapatch, VA on January 6, 1929, and was the son of the late Lucian Woosley and Maude Sparks Woosley. After graduating high school, he worked as coal miner for Jewell Ridge Coal Company and Pittston Coal Company, for 41 years. He was the financial secretary of the UMWA Local #7327. He was a 57-year resident of Richlands after moving from Jewell Ridge, Virginia. He served as a magistrate from 1972 to 1979, for the 29th Judicial District of Virginia; and was a 30-year member of the Richlands Volunteer Rescue Squad. Peery was of the Baptist faith

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife of 61 years Ruby Childress Woosley; and two brothers, Thomas L. Woosley and Johnny R. Woosley; and sisters-in-law, Greta Woosley, Eva Woosley, and Jacqueline Burke.

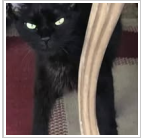
