Mr. Perry A. Compton, age 85, of Richlands, Virginia, passed away Saturday, September 27, 2008 at his home following a lengthy illness. He was born in Russell County and was the son of the late Burl and Amanda Newberry Compton, both Russell County natives. He had made his home in the Tazewell County area all of his life and was a retired miner for Red Jacket and Red Ash Coal Companies. He was a charter member of the Richlands Rescue Squad and was a member of the Tazewell County Sportsmen Club. He was a member of the Mill Creek Primitive Baptist Church. He was a U.S. Navy World War II Veteran and was a member of the Casey Shortt VFW Post #9640.
