Priscilla Altizer Russ, 81, of Richlands, Virginia, passed away peacefully on October 22, 2021, at her home following a fearless battle with cancer.

She was "Mom" to any friend her boys brought through the door. Known for her sharp wit and honesty, she valued her countless friendships as an invaluable treasure. Her kind heart drove a willingness to sacrifice and help anyone in need as her door was always open.

She was a member of the Red Hat Society (Queen Mother of the Richlands chapter), and the First United Methodist Church of Richlands and served on the Richlands Garden Club and the Planning Commission.
