Rev. Jerry Willard Casey, age 76, of Richlands, Virginia, passed away Friday, October 22, 2010 in a Bristol, Tennessee hospital following a brief illness. He had made his home in the Richlands area all of his life and was the pastor of the Friendly Chapel Church on Smith Ridge for the past 45 years.
