Robert "Nabbie" Asbury, Jr. age 83 of North Tazewell, VA went to be with his Lord Saturday, January 3, 2009 with all his loving family by his bedside at Wellmont Hospice House in Bristol, TN. Born June 30, 1925 at Boissevain, VA he was a son of the late Robert Asbury, Sr. and Ollie Mae Sayers Asbury. He was a retired coal miner, having worked for Consolidated Coal Company and he had also worked for General Instruments. His first job as a young boy was working for the Amonate Company Store.
