Robert E. Lee Harman, age 74 of the Abbs Valley community of Bluefield, VA died Wednesday, December 26, 2012 at Bluefield Regional Medical Center in Bluefield, WV. He was born December 21, 1938 at Abbs Valley, VA and was a son of the late Sidney E. Harman, Sr. and Mary Brooks Harman. Mr. Harman was a United States Air Force veteran of both the Korean and Vietnam wars. He was a graduate of both Pocahontas High School in Pocahontas, VA and Danville Technical Institute in Danville, VA.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by one nephew, Sidney E. Harman, III.

Survivors include two brothers, Kirk Dennis Harman and wife, Shirley of Mt. Hope, WV and Sidney E.
