Rocky Allen Shelton, age 25 of Richlands, Virginia passed away, Wednesday, October 12, 2011 in Russell County, Virginia following injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident. He was born in Richlands, Virginia and was the son of Allen and Nannie Boyd Shelton of the Paintlick section of Pounding Mill, Virginia. He was a 2003 Richlands High School graduate where he was a member of the Varsity Baseball and Football Teams. He attended Bluefield College and was a member of Bluefield Rams Baseball Team. He worked for Bailey-Wells Construction and also played rugby for the Clinch River Crusaders. Rocky enjoyed coaching the Richlands 15-16 year old All-Star Team in which they went to State Finals for two consecutive years. He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Robert and Ethel Nipper Boyd of Shortts Gap, Virginia; and Earl and Lorraine Salyers Shelton of the Hill Creek section of Richlands, Virginia.
