February 24, 1924 - April 9, 2011

Rodger Austin Mosley, age 87 of Richlands, passed away April 9, 2011 at his home. He was born February 24, 1924 in Shortts Gap, Virginia and was the son of the late Franklin and Louisa Bucklen Mosley. He was a lifelong resident of the area and was a retired miner from Pittston Coal Company with over 40 years of experience. He was a decorated Army veteran who served his country in France during World War II. During his service, he was awarded the American Theater Service Ribbon, the European African Middle Eastern Service Ribbon, World War II Victory Ribbon, and the Good Conduct Medal. After his discharge from the Army, he went to work in the coal mine. He was a member of Richlands Presbyterian Church and United Mine Workers of America Local #1256. He enjoyed gardening, cooking, and volunteering in the community. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by brothers: James Percival, John, and Harold Mosley and one sister, Trudell Shortt.
