Mr. Roosevelt Stinson, age 69, of 4990 Ridge Rd. Seagrove, North Carolina formerly of Cedar Bluff, Virginia, died Saturday, March 27th, 2004 in an Ashboro, North Carolina hospital following a lengthy illness.
