Rosemary Studebaker Lotito, 71, of Pounding Mill, Va., died Monday, September 10, 2018, of a sudden illness.

Born in Bluefield, W.Va., she was the daughter of the late Major John M. and Rosemary Hooks Studebaker. A graduate of Bluefield High School, she earned her B.A. degree from East Tennessee State University and also studied at East Carolina University.

She was a longtime member of the Richlands First United Methodist Church.

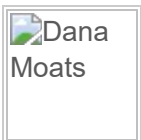

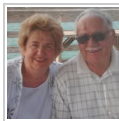
