Phillip Shane Patrick, age 47, of Lebanon, VA, passed away on Saturday, February 1, 2020 at Johnston Memorial Hospital in Abingdon, Virginia.

Shane was born on June 6, 1972 in Richlands, VA and was the son of Wilma Geneva Hill Skeens of Lebanon, VA and the late Raymond “Pug” Patrick. Shane was a class of 1990 graduate of Richlands High School. He served his country in the U.S. Army during the Gulf War. He received his Bachelor’s degree from Northeastern State University and his Master’s degree from Texas A & M. Shane was a network engineer for Verizon for 24 years.
