Reverend Stephen Phillip Tegeler, age 60, of Pounding Mill, Virginia, passed away on Saturday, December 28, 2019.

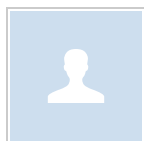

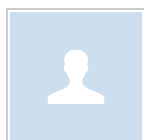

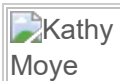
