William Lawrence Ratliff, age 85, of Richlands, Virginia, passed away Tuesday, November 23, 2010 in a Richlands, Virginia hospital. He was born in Buchanan County and was the son of the late Adam Poe and Eva Harman Ratliff. He was a member of the Richlands Tabernacle for over 40 years and was a proud World War II U.S. Navy Veteran having served his country in the North African and European Theatre. After World War II, he went to work for Cadillac in Detroit, Michigan. He returned to Richlands in 1957 and was the owner and operator of Lawrence Ratliff Trucking for 20 years. He also worked in the mining industry having operated heavy equipment for PERMAC for 20 years. After retiring, he returned to work for Pounding Mill Quarry where he worked until his second retirement in 1996. He enjoyed recreational aviation and enjoyed flying out of the Doran airport for years.
