March 5, 1918 - March 19, 2009

Mr. Woodrow Wilson McGuire age, 91 of Bandy, Virginia passed away Thursday, March 19, 2009 while surrounded by his loving family at his home following a lengthy illness. He was born in Bandy, Virginia and was the son of the late Charles Finley and Flora Ann Harrison McGuire, both former Tazewell County natives. Woodrow unselfishly served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II as he bravely fought in the campaign of The Rhineland, for his single acts of merit or meritorious service he was awarded the Bronze Star and he was also awarded the Purple Heart for wounds he received during battle. He was of the Protestant faith and was a lifetime resident of the area and worked as a rural mail carrier in the Bandy area for many years before retiring.
